General Membership Meeting Minutes

President, Brian Cheney - Open the meeting and called the meeting to order @ 6:35 PM.

The meeting began with a motion to approve the Minutes from the July General Membership meeting. A motion was made and seconded and the membership voted:

Financial Report – Jim Arntz gave the financial report from June 1, 2009 thru July 31, 2009. The beginning cash balance was \$26,143.80; the income \$6,865.00 total expenses \$10,573.58 with an ending balance of \$22,435.22. Jim noted that as of May 31, 2009 the Budget for banquet balance paid out (\$4,800.00). The beginning cash for Sand Dollar/Whitlow is (\$18,000.00); the estimated cash is (\$364.78).
